The Upper Midwest Chapter of the Club Managers' Association of America (CMAA) represents the Club Management Profession in Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota and part of Wisconsin. Its membership consists of over 65 Professional Managers in Private, Country, City University, Yacht and Town Clubs.

We hope that this completed application will result in an award that will be of financial assistance and encouragement for pursuit of interest in this exciting career field.

Who is it for?

Based on merit, it is for individuals who are interested in a career in the Private Club industry. Full-time students attending an accredited four-year College or University may apply.

Scholarship Awards

The Chapter awards a limited number of scholarships each year. The amount is determined by the Chapter members and the Scholarship Committee and approved by the Chapter. Scholarship Awards are made directly to the Registrar at the College or University.

Criteria

Candidates must show evidence of employment interest in the Club Management Profession. They must have completed their freshman year in a four-year College or University, have maintained, and continue to maintain a grade point average of at least 2.0.

The Application Checklist

To apply for a CMAA Scholarship, follow these simple steps:

1. Fill out this application completely.
2. Write an essay of no more than 500 words stating your career objectives, your interest in the Club Management fields and why you should be the recipient of a Scholarship.
3. Attach a copy of your College transcript(s) to the completed application. All information must be received by the Chapter by July.
4. Include copies of endorsements from a Professor and a Club Manager. Endorsement forms are included with the application.

Note: The application must be legible or your rating may be adversely affected. Points are awarded for overall presentation.

Applications or questions should be directed to the President of the Upper Midwest Chapter or your Student Liaison.

All information must be received by July 1 of each year. Decisions on awards will be made by the Scholarship Committee and the Chapter in August.
