- A minimum 2-year degree in Turf Grass Management.
- Must possess or have the ability to obtain a MN Pesticide Applicator's license.
- Must have a valid driver's license.

- Knowledge of management and maintenance of greens, tees, fairways, and roughs.
- Knowledge of use and operating standards of equipment and tools used in golf course construction and maintenance work.
- Demonstrated skill in recruiting, supervising, training, monitoring, evaluating, and motivating a team.
- Demonstrated interpersonal skills to resolve conflict and work with supervisors, officials, employees, members, guests, contractors, and the general public.
- Knowledge of safe use, mixing and application of chemicals and commercial products.
- Knowledge of the game of golf, golf rules, and methods of play.
- Demonstrated ability to anticipate team, equipment, and material requirements related to golf course maintenance and repair assignments.
- Ability and knowledge to lay out irrigation patterns, drainage patterns, and perform course construction work.
- Must be able to work independently and be a self-starting problem solver.
- Advance computer skills required for financial reporting and control of operations, including use of Microsoft Office Suite.
